

Knitting & Crochet Patterns for Remembrance Poppies

For both crochet and knitted poppies please finish with a safety pin sewn onto the back.

Crochet Pattern - Four Petal Poppy

4mm crochet hook, black and red double-knit yarn

Round 1 Using black, work into a magic ring, 1 ch, 8 dc, join to 1st dc with sl stitch. DO NOT FULLY CLOSE MAGIC RING. (8dc)

Round 2 1 ch (does not count as stitch), working over Round 1 stitches: 16 dc into ring, join to 1st dc with slip stitch. Fasten off, leaving a long thread to sew on safety pin. Close magic ring. (16dc)

Round 3 Using red, join with sl st in any stitch, *miss 1 st, 6 tr in next st, miss 1 st, sl st in next stitch, repeat from * 3 more times, ending with sl st in starting sl st (24 tr + 4 sl st)

Round 4 *1 ch, (miss 1 st, 2 tr between next 2 stitches) 5 times, 1 ch, miss st, working over Round 3 sl st, sl st in Round 2; repeat from * 3 more times, ending with sl st in starting sl stitch. Fasten off. (40 tr + 8 1ch spaces + 4 sl st)

Weave in ends and attach safety pin to back of poppy.

Crochet Pattern - Two Petal Poppy

Rounds 1 & 2 As 4 petal poppies above

Round 3 Using red, join with a sl st in any stitch, *1 ch, 1 htr, 1 tr, 2 tr in each of next 3 sts, 1 tr, 1 htr, 1 ch, sl st in next stitch, repeat from * once more, ending with sl st in starting sl st. (16 tr + 4 htr + 4 1 ch spaces + 2 sl st)

Round 4 * 1 ch, (miss 1 st, 2 tr between next 2 sts) 9 times, 1 ch, miss 1 st, working over Round 3 sl st, sl st in Round 2; repeat from * once more, ending with sl st in starting sl st. Fasten off. Weave in ends and attach safety pin to back of poppy. (36 tr + 4 1ch spaces + 2 sl st)

Knitted Garter Stitch Poppy Pattern

Using red double-knit yarn and size 3.5 or 3.75 needles cast on 120 stitches.

Rows 1-4 knit

Row 5 knit 3 together across row (40 stitches)

Rows 6-9 knit

Row 10 knit 2tog across row (20 stitches)

Rows 11- 14 knit

Row 15 knit 2 together across row (10 stitches)

Cut yarn leaving a tail of about 20 cm. Thread tail through remaining 10 stitches and pull tight. Pull around into a circle and sew seam. Add a button or French knots for centre.
